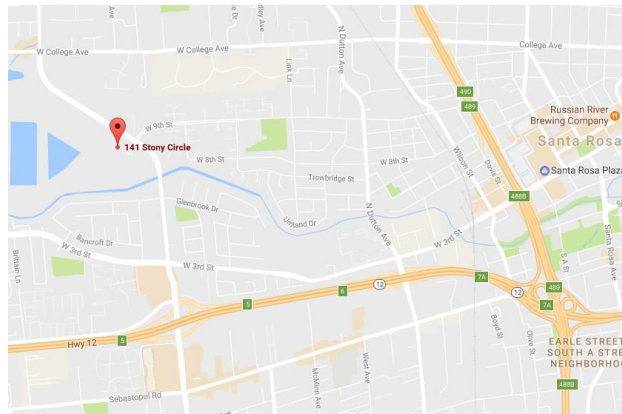

Education Services

Head Start/ Early Head Start

A national child and family development program for low-income children 0-5 years old and their families. The goal is to promote school readiness by enhancing the social and cognitive development of children through the provision of educational, health, nutritional, social, and other services to enrolled children and families.
