## Eligible for Season of Sharing (SOS) support

- Low-to-moderate income families with dependent children under 18
- Seniors age 55 and older
- Disabled individuals
- U.S. Veterans
- Victims of domestic violence
- Pregnant women in the 2nd or 3rd trimester
- Emancipated foster youth up to age 24
- Some fire-related losses
